#### **Purpose of Updating Constitution and Bylaws**

- Define key committees' membership, terms and basic responsibilities in Committee Chapter including: Mission, Endowment, Nominating and Finance Committees
- Re-organize Nominating Committee section to simplify
- Add required ELCA changes
- Clarify section on financial and business responsibilities with addition of Finance Committee in 2021
- Correct any identified typos

### **Review and Approval Process 2020**

- 1. March-June: Review and initial drafts of changes by Executive Committee
- 2. June: Council review, discussion and approval of general concept and "Review and Approval Process"
- July-August: Key Committee chairs and committees (Finance, Mission, Nominating and Endowment) and Trinity leaders review and make recommendations (More than 35 Trinity leaders involved!)
- 4. September: Council reviews and approves recommendations or sends back to Committee chairs for further discussion and recommendations
- October: Send to ELCA Synod for review and approval (required) and make recommended updates
- 6. November: Council to finalize and approve "final version"
- December: Distribute to Congregation (12/9/20) at least 30 days before annual Congregation Meeting per bylaws for review and comments; return to ELCA for their final approval
- 8. January: Adult Forum (1/10/21) presented information with comment opportunity
- 9. January: Final review and approval by Congregation at Congregational Meeting.




